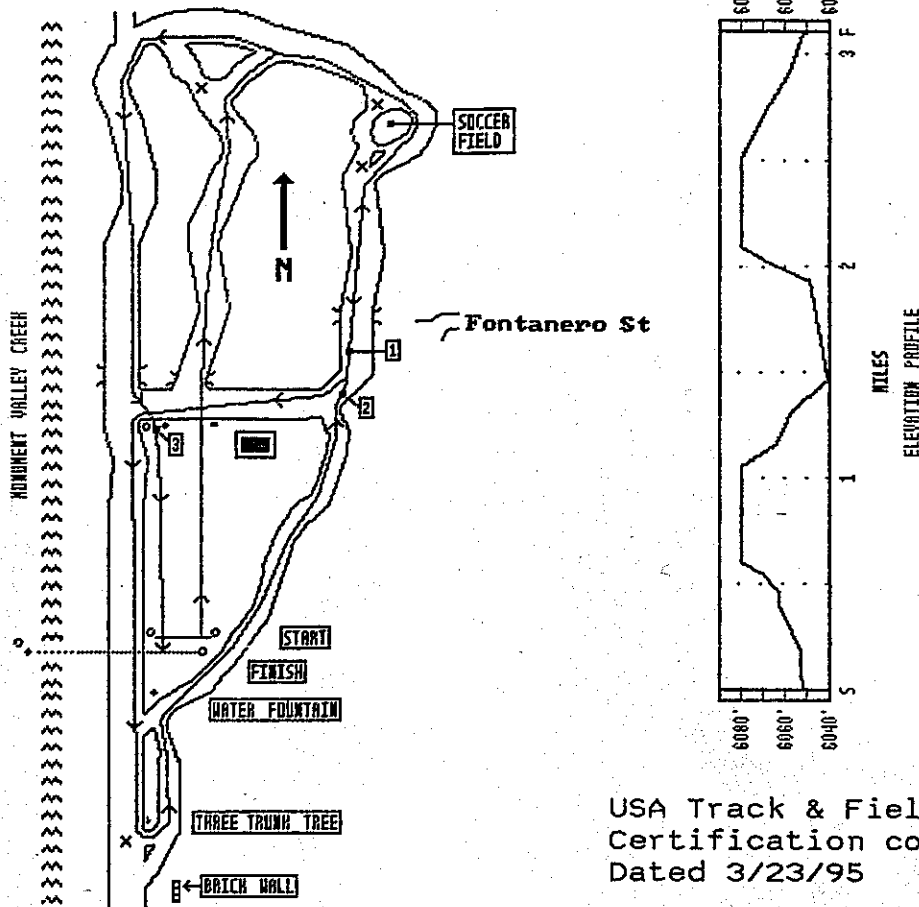


**NORTH MONUMENT VALLEY
5 Kilometer Course**



USA Track & Field Course

COURSE DESCRIPTION

- START** - Same as High School. In line with South edge of two large trees at opposite ends of the starting line. This is 28.5 feet North of the lone deciduous tree in the middle of the grassy area.
- MILE 1** - On path just South of Fontanero Street, 5.3 feet north of support cable for utility pole #002432.
- MAIN PATH TURNOFF** - 19.8 feet South of south edge of three trunk tree where concrete circular platform touches the southwest corner of the trunk. This is about 50 yards North of a large rock wall.
- MILE 2** - 85 feet uphill from the intersection of paths at the bottom of a steep hill. On the South side there are two trees close to the trail. The mark is 3.6 feet East of the lower one and 5.6 feet West of the upper one.
- MILE 3** - 25.1' South of point at which course leaves the dirt and becomes grass. There is an 8" spike in the ground at this point. The head of the spike is just below the surface 6.05' West of the "Pooper Scooper" sign.
- FINISH** - At south end of grassy area in line with a small deciduous tree and the first fence post South of smallest power pole on the railroad property. Line of sight is over the top edge of the rock wall just at the beginning of the down slope.

X's - indicate places where either cones or monitors should be placed to insure runners follow the proper route.

8" spikes have been driven into the ground at each location.
